

KAY PENNEY “LOVE OF GUIDING” AWARD

Girl Guides of Canada – Guides du Canada, Newfoundland and Labrador Council, has developed this award to commemorate the four-year term of our Past Provincial Commissioner, Kay Penney, to recognize the efforts of an outstanding Girl Member of the Organization who meets the following criteria. It can be given more than once, to the same person at any level, but not within the same Branch of Guiding.

Criteria

- Registered Member of the Girl Guides of Canada
- Any level of Guiding, i.e. Sparks, Brownies, Guides, Pathfinders, Rangers
- Enthusiastic about sharing the joy of the Sisterhood of Guiding
- Regularly attends Unit meetings and eagerly participates in organized activities
- Interacts well with others
- Acts as a Role Model for her Peers
- Lends a Hand
- Thinks of Others
- Shows enthusiasm when completing Program and Badge work
- Actively participates in Community Service
- Participates in both the Spring and Fall Cookie Campaigns

There will be a nomination form signed by a Registered Guider, accompanied by one letter of support from another Registered Guider, outlining how the criteria was met.

The Award will consist of a framed Certificate for the Girl and a perpetual plaque for Provincial Office. Name of the successful recipient to be announced at the Provincial Annual General Meeting followed by a presentation at the year-end Banquet, of the level concerned.

LOG.NL-1 Basic Information - Nominee

The nominating Guider must sign the nomination form

LOG.NL-2 Confidential Recommendation – Guiding

A recommendation is required from one (1) active member of Girl Guides of Canada who is not related to the nominee

Regarding Confidential Recommendations

An information sheet pertaining to the Award is provided. Please ensure that the person asked to provide a recommendation receives a copy of the Award criteria. It is important to assure the person giving the reference that any information provided in the recommendation will be strictly confidential.
